Get more from MangoDocs

- **MangoDocs Check-Out/Check-In**
 - Any document can now be checked-out for editing by a user. You can do this via the 'Check Out' action on the document's actions menu. By checking out the file you are telling your co-workers that you are editing this document and have taken a lock on it. The file will remain locked (checked-out) until you release it. You can release the lock by either checking-in the new version of the file back or discarding the check out operation This helps avoid confusion among team members working on the same document.
 - Domain admins can discard the checked-out lock taken by a user.
 - With checkout filters in the project get visibility into who has checked-out the documents.
 - All checked out documents have a red dot in their icons for easy identification.
- **Give your external users (clients, partners, suppliers) ability to download the shared document**
 - Now when you share a document with external users in a project or group you can give them permission to download it now in addition to the view privileges
 - On the File Details Page, in the Public Users section you can view the list of external users who have view access to the document along with who all have download access now.
- **Document collaboration via comments is now turned-on by default**
 - In MangoDocs anytime you upload files the ability to comment on it is now turned-on by default. This gives users the ability to immediately share their inputs on these files
 - As before you as the owner of the file have the ability to turn off comments giving you full control over it.

Want more from your Wikis too? Here you go!

- **Convert Posts to Wikis**
 - Now you can convert your existing post in the project or group into a wiki with just 1-click.
 - Converting a post to a wiki gives you all the wikis features instantaneously including full version history for future edits, ability to organize it in a hierarchy of pages & much more.
- **Type Ahead search and 1-click print of project/group wikis**
 - Now the 'Search All' box as you type in has an ability to look ahead in your wikis to show you the ones that satisfy your search criteria
 - You can now get all the wiki pages in your project or group printed as PDF with 1-click. That makes taking a PDF of all the wikis pages in the project/group super easy.
- **Embed images into your wiki pages**
 - Click on the "Images" button when you are in the Edit mode of wikis and you now have the ability to
 - Add images from the web &
 - Add images from the desktop
 - You get this ability to add images across MangoApps in your project/group posts, Ideas & Idea campaigns also now.

And..we continue to work on MangoIdeas

- Get your Idea & Idea Campaigns updates over email now. You control what emails you get via your standard "Email Notifications" page.
- Now when you convert ideas into projects you get your idea details including comments, tags & files carried forward to your projects. This way you have all the information you need to get started on the project.
- Users now have the ability to create tasks from Ideas. Give your users a jump-start in evaluating the ideas by creating tasks and getting visibility into the progress of these tasks. This capability is available in domains that have both MangoIdeas & MangoTasks apps enabled.

Improved User Experience:

- We have added a bunch of user experience improvements to the new MangoApps Web GUI. Try these out and we would love to get your feedback on them.
- New Re-designed Dashboard for easy & fast navigation to updates & messages that matter to you.
- A "What's New?" section gives you a very convenient place to see all your relevant updates which you have not read. Under "What's New?" look for the "blue dot" next to the feeds that you have not marked read. Clicking on the blue dot marks the feed read and removes it from your "What's New" filter. You can mark all the updates on 1 page as read with just a 1-click action - "Mark all as Read".
- Get a history of pages that you have recently navigated in MangoApps with just 1-click giving you fast access to content that you have recently viewed. Look for a new icon next to your name on the top right to get access to your recent navigation history.
- "Watch" is now called "Bookmark" - Bookmark any feed that you would like to get back to later. There is a 'Bookmarks' filter on the dashboard to give you easy access to all your earlier bookmarked feeds.
- Timesheets are more public now. You by default get view only access to your co-workers timesheets via their profile pages.
- Task & Activity Report has now been enhanced to have links to the tasks that were created from the activity so that you can take the next action on them right from the report itself. This is available to MangoTasks domain.
- You can now search for any task using its Task Id or Task Name in your pending tasks list page to get your task faster. This is available to MangoTasks domain.
- Your Blog archives are now classified per month for your readers to get fast & easy access to the your older archives.

Just for Admins:

- You as a domain admin can now decide if you want project & groups owners to have the ability to delete their owned projects/groups. By default they continue to have this ability but you can choose to turn it off from "Domain Configuration" in the Admin portal.
- Project & group owners now have the ability to assign additional project/group members to have admin privileges in their projects.
